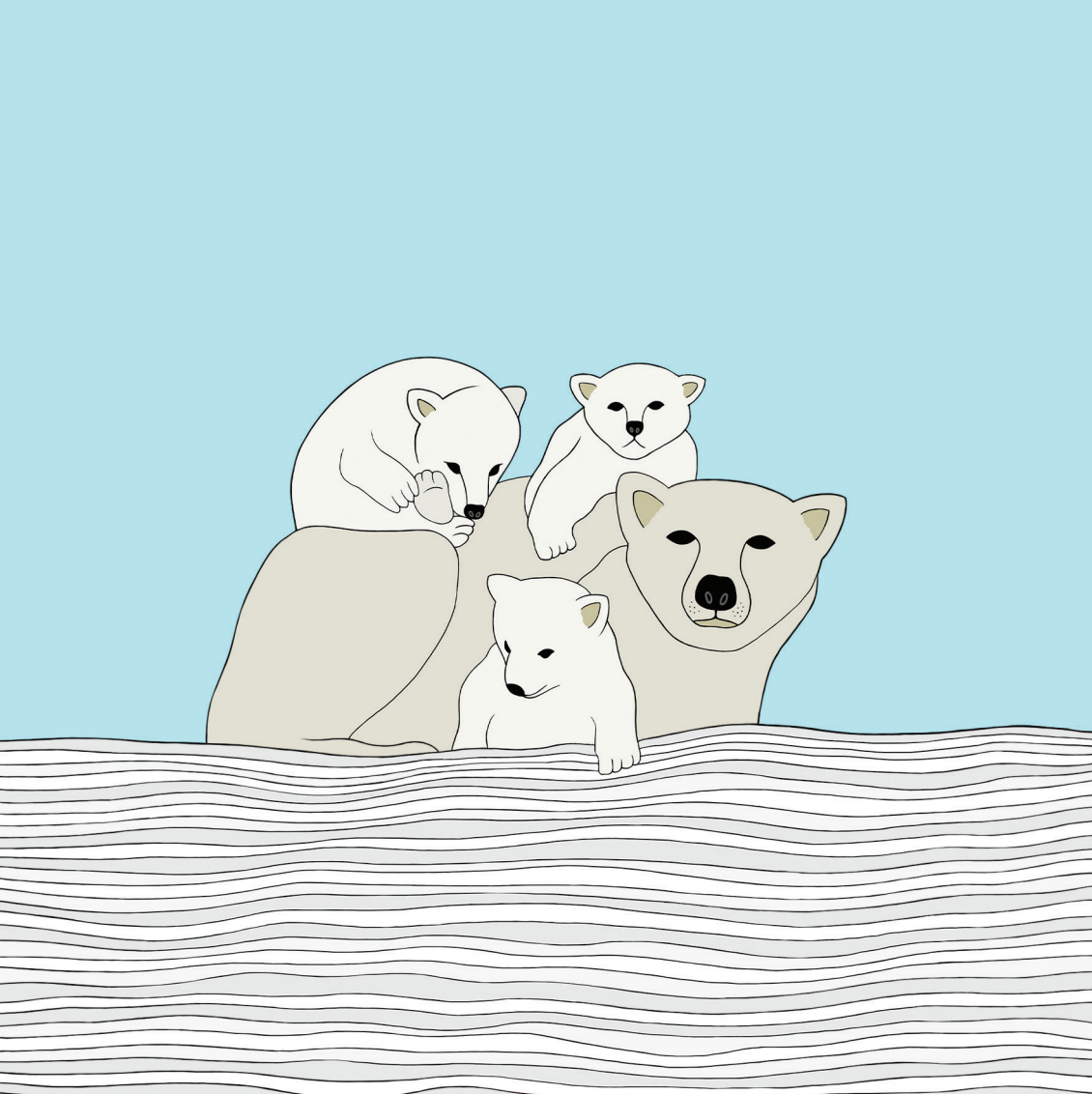




A **daddy polar bear** is called a **boar**.

than a jar of honey.






A **daddy penguin** is called a **cock**.  
A **baby penguin** is called a **chick**.

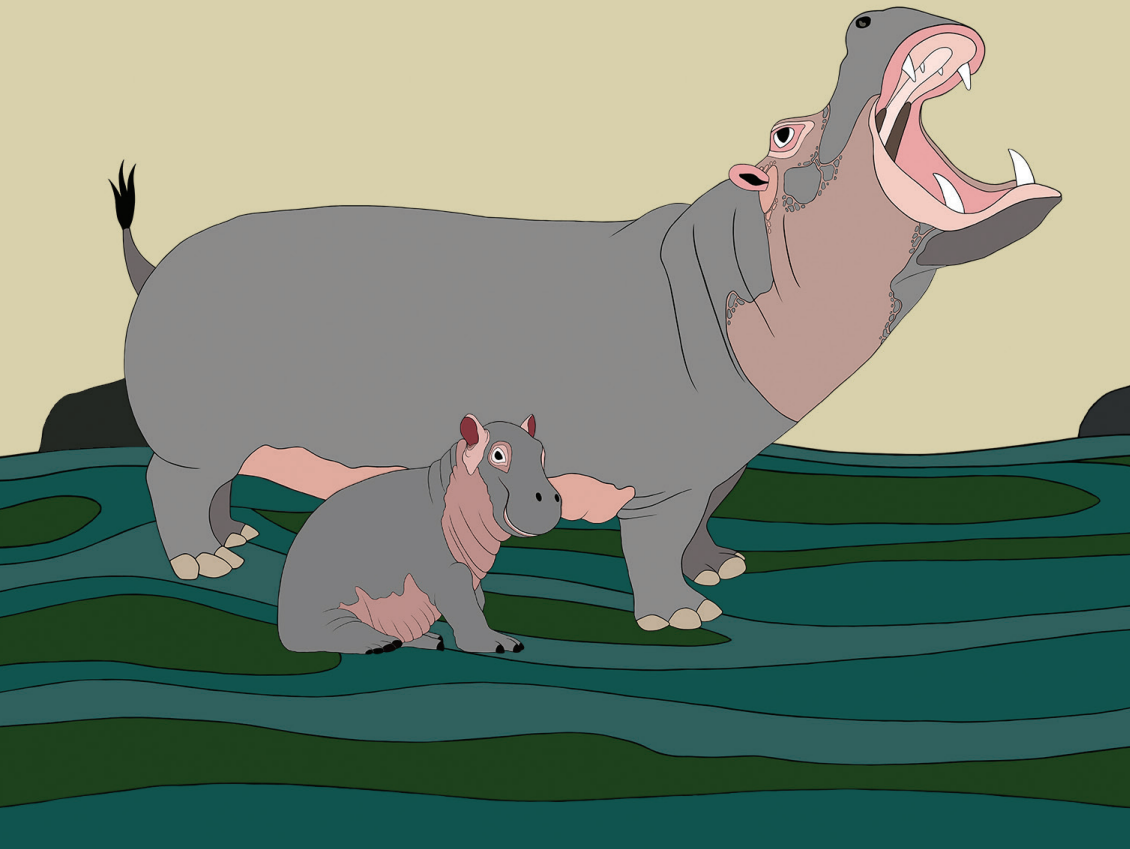
While his mate looks for food, an Emperor cock balances their egg on his toes, warm and safe next to his tummy and well away from the ice.






A **daddy hippopotamus** is called a **bull**.
