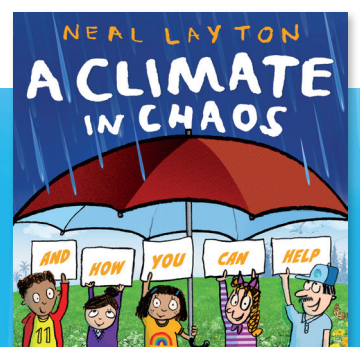


DESIGN A POSTER

THE GOOD AND BAD EFFECTS ON CLIMATE CHANGE

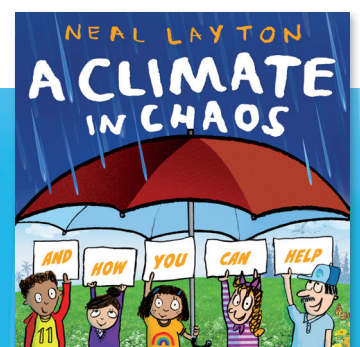
Can you identify which activities or things below have good or bad effects on climate change and sort them into the correct columns?

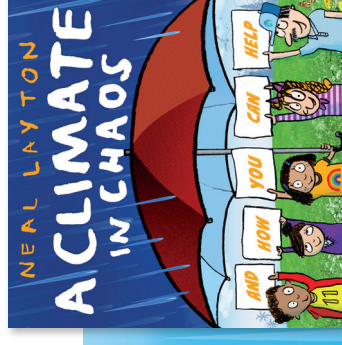
